## DID YOU KNOW:

- ▶ There are few things in life that bring more joy to a family than the birth of a child. Some **60** babies a year are born to St. Marys moms at Stratford General
- ▶ We take care of **8** special care nursery infants from St. Marys
- ▶ **21** young children from St. Marys stay in our paediatric unit
- ▶ Yearly about **110** St. Marys residents come to Stratford General for surgery
- ▶ Some **10** people from St. Marys count on our intensive care unit
- ▶ Mental illness can affect anyone... **4 out of 5** Ontarians know someone who has experienced mental illness. About **27** people yearly from St. Marys need inpatient mental health services
- ▶ **220** people from St. Marys had a CT Scan
