With just months to go before the Grand Opening of the new North Wing, the Foundation is working hard to ensure we recognize all our precious donors at the appropriate level and in the manner that they wish. A central part of that recognition is listing our donors on our new donor wall that will be located in the new "link lobby", a high-traffic location linking the new North Wing to the existing hospital.

We have a number of gift levels for our donor recognition wall.

Donors gifts to the Heart & Soul Campaign/redevelopment are cumulative. We are sending out over 1,000

letters to donors who are eligible to have their name on the wall. There is still plenty of opportunity to be recognized at the donor wall level and there are still room naming opportunities from \$10,000 and up. About 80 rooms/spaces are named so far ensuring a lasting legacy. Pledges over 5 years allow donors to maximize their support.

According to Andrea Page, Executive Director, Stratford General Hospital Foundation and Campaign Director—every dollar counts and over 9,000 people from throughout Huron, Perth and Oxford Counties have given already.
